excessive investment drives down returns and leads inexorably to a bust this was the case with both the technology bubble at the turn of the century and the us housing bubble which followed shortly after more recently vast sums have been invested in mining and energy from an investor s perspective the trick is to avoid investing in sectors or markets where investment spending is unduly elevated and competition is fierce and to put one s money to work where capital expenditure is depressed competitive conditions are more favourable and as a result prospective investment returns are higher this capital cycle strategy encourages investors to eschew the simple growth and value dichotomy and identify firms that can deliver superior returns either because capital has been taken out of an industry or because the business has strong barriers to entry what warren buffett refers to as a moat some of marathon s most successful investments have come from obscure sometimes niche operations whose businesses are protected from the destructive forces of the capital cycle capital returns is a comprehensive introduction to the theory and practical implementation of the capital cycle approach
